Playground Rules

Parents and siblings at lunch:

1. No parents or siblings on the playground at all. They can watch from the sidewalk.

<u>Swings:</u>

- 1. Always swing the same direction. "Feet to the street."
- 2. Count to 25 to get your turn.
- 3. Only swing straight. Don't twist the swing or swing sideways.
- 4. Do not hold hands with another student while swinging.
- 5. No jumping out of the swings.
- 6. No pushing anyone on the swings.

Small Jungle Gym:

- 1. One person goes across the bars at once.
- 2. You only go one direction on the bars. Start from the Jungle Gym and go out.
- 3. Go down the slide one at a time.

Sand Diggers:

- 1. One person at a time uses the Sand Digger.
- 2. Count to 25 to get your turn.
- 3. Do not dig underneath the Sand Digger with your hand.

Spider Web Monkey Bars:

- 1. Only 5 students on top of the Monkey Bars.
- 2. Do not hang upside down.

Big Jungle Gym:

- 1. Do not play tag on the Jungle Gym.
- 2. One person at a time down the slide.
- 3. Do not run on the Jungle Gym.
- 4. Get on the Jungle Gym from the stairs or the climbing bars. Do not go through the bridge.

<u>Sand:</u>

- 1. Do not throw sand at all.
- 2. Fill in the holes before you go in from recess.
- 3. Do not dig under the bridge on the big Jungle

Gym.

<u>Teeter Totter:</u>

- 1. Only 2 people at a time on the Teeter Totter.
- 2. Make one line and count to 25 to get your turn.
- 3. Do not sit or play in the middle of the teeter totter.
- 4. Face forward with hands on handle.

<u>Drinks:</u>

- 1. Do not play with the drinking fountain.
- 2. Count to 5 to get your turn.

General:

- 1. No pushing, shoving, or hitting.
- 2. Walk, do not run, on the sidewalk.
- 3. Walk on the sidewalk, not the grass, to get to the playground.



K through 8th Grade Drop-Off Procedures:

Option 1: Students remain in the car until it reaches the Student Drop-Off Designated Area. Students may exit the vehicle at this time. Exit the parking lot safely.

Option 2: Park in the parking lot. Using the crosswalks escort your student(s) to the gate. Upon returning to your vehicle exit safely in the Drive-Thru Line. Exit the parking lot safely.

DO NOT DROP OFF AND LEAVE YOUR CHILD UNATTENDED

Please note: unattended students dropped off before 8:15 will be placed in Extended Day. When a child is placed in Extended Day a fee is charged.

If you choose to walk your student(s) to the gate, use the crosswalk on 27th Ave. Please do not block bus alley or hinder the busses getting into the bus bay.

Friendly Reminder to All Parents:


If you are on school campus and using a video camera, camera or other recording devices, please remember you can only photograph your own child and must obtain permission to film or photograph other children while involved in school activities..

Parent-Teacher Conferences: A Checklist for Success

• Make a positive impression. Walk in with



a smile, and be on time. *Tip*: It's best not to take younger children along.

• Listen carefully to what the teacher tells you. If you don't understand something, ask him/her to explain.

- Ask questions about your child's academic progress, social relationships, and behavior.
- Work with the teacher to develop an action plan to help your youngster succeed. List things you and your child can do at home to help him/her do his best in school.
- Plan to follow-up with the teacher. Would he/she prefer that you write notes, call, or send e-mails?

Questions to Ask

Wondering what questions to ask your child's teacher? Try these for a start:

- What are my child's strengths and weaknesses in your class?
- Is my youngster performing at grade level?
- Is he/she working to the best of his ability?
- Does my child need special help in any subjects? Does he/she need help with his learning or test-taking skills?
- Are you concerned about any learning problems?
- Is my child completing class work and homework on time? Does he/she take part in class discussions?
- How does he/she get along with the other kids? What activities does he/she participate in during recess? Who does he/she play with most often?
- What can I do at home to help my youngster succeed?


