

Unpaid Meal Charge Policy

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Alhambra Elementary School District is pleased to offer **breakfast and lunch at no cost to all Alhambra enrolled students for the 22-23 school year**, regardless of meal eligibility status. Please note that an annual Child Nutrition Form is still required for each household. Please visit <https://www.alhambraesd.org/Page/738> to view our Child Nutrition Form Flyer to determine which form is needed from your household.

While students may receive one breakfast and one lunch daily at no cost, students choosing to have a second breakfast or lunch will need to pay the full price of the meal. Students must bring money or have sufficient funds on their Titan meal account to cover the price of their second meal or extra milk, should they choose to purchase. Students are not allowed to accrue a negative balance for the purchase of second meals or extra milk. The prices of second meals and extra milk are as follows:

Second Breakfast:	\$1.00
Second Lunch:	\$2.70
Extra Milk:	\$0.25

There are several ways to add money to your student's meal account for second meals or extra milk. Parents may send money with their child in the form of cash, check (\$20.00 returned check fee) or money order to be paid directly to the cafeteria. Payment may also be made online at <https://family.titank12.com/6TR85Q> using Visa, MasterCard or Discover (a transaction fee of \$2.60 will be applied to online payments). Parents/guardians may contact the school cafeteria at any time during business hours or use <https://family.titank12.com/> free of charge 24 hours per day to check the balance of your child's account and/or to view daily meal transactions. You may also set up a free email reminder for low balances online; the website will work with any mobile device web browser as well.
