- COVID Protocols Update
 - When a student tests positive they remain home for 5 days and until testing negative. Siblings will still attend and will mask.
 - We test students who display extreme symptoms.
 - Recommend masks for those with symptoms.
- GAP enrollment
 - GAP has grown! We grew from 180 at the end of last year to nearly 300 students this year. We are including new students and showing them the GAP way.
 - We also have new staff members.
 - There will be new news coming out regarding an additional staff member.
