## Riding Valley Metro is easy...

- 1. Plan your trip online at *valleymetro.org* or Google transit, call us at 602.253.5000 or use the transit book.
- Buy your fare at one of the many retail outlets, rail fare vending machines or online at <u>valleymetro.org/where-to-buy</u>. A one ride reduced fare on bus or rail is \$1. A 1-Day Pass is \$2 for unlimited rides on bus and rail that day.

## **Ride Bus Right**

- Get to your bus stop 5 minutes early and have your fare ready. Check the destination sign as the bus approaches and give the driver a wave. Wear a face mask to protect yourself and others. Face coverings are required on Valley Metro vehicles.
- Currently you will board through the back door and show the driver your fare. Take a seat and keep a safe distance from others.
- Watch and listen for your stop. Signal the operator that you would like the next stop by pulling the cord or pushing the button or strip around the window.
- Exit the bus through the back door.



# **Ride Rail Right**

- Get to the light rail station 5 minutes before the train is expected and buy or activate your fare. Make sure of the direction you are traveling and choose the right train to board. Wear a face mask to protect yourself and others. Face coverings are required on Valley Metro vehicles.
- Board through the closest door and take a seat or stand and hold on. Keep a safe distance from others.
- The train will stop at each station. Watch and listen for your station and exit through the closest door.
