



Ethics/Code of Conduct

In order to be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, a student must meet identified academic and behavioral standards according to the Alhambra Elementary School District Governing Board Policy JJJ.

- ✓ Students who, upon having their work checked on a cumulative basis at the beginning and mid-point of each 10-week sports season or club, show that they are not working to capacity and have one (1) or more failing grades will be removed from any athletic teams or extracurricular activities. After improving their respective grades such that they are passing on a cumulative basis, they shall be reinstated to the teams or extracurricular activities until a subsequent check is performed unless ineligible for some reason other than academic performance.
- ✓ The eligibility criterion for extracurricular participation shall be a passing grade in all classes in which the student is enrolled, and the student shall maintain progress toward promotion.
- ✓ Students whose behavior presents a problem or jeopardizes school discipline may be ineligible for participation in extracurricular activities until such time as their behavior warrants reinstatement.
- ✓ If a student is absent from school, regardless of the reason, the student will not be allowed to participate in any extracurricular function on the evening of the day on which the absence occurs. Participation in weeknight activities is not an excuse for absence on the day following the activity.
- ✓ The same general standards shall apply for special education students except that such eligibility shall be determined on a case-by-case basis in relationship to the respective students' individual education programs.

All students need to remember that they are not only representing themselves, but also the Alhambra Elementary School District, their school and their community in all of their actions. With this in mind, it is hoped that all of our students' actions reflect a positive position toward each other, our opponents, and the obligations that are accepted as part of participation in extracurricular activities. There shall be immediate suspension from the extracurricular activity program if it is determined that a student participating in extracurricular activities has broken the law, maliciously destroyed property, had possession of or used tobacco, alcohol, drugs, controlled substances, or possessing drug paraphernalia, has participated in initiation, or has been guilty of other conduct unbecoming a student participating in extracurricular activities. All violations shall be reported by any school official and may be reported by any person to the Principal, Coach, or Club Sponsor involved.
